Contacting the Teacher

Course Website

All the assignments and rubrics (when possible) will be posted on the website along with due dates. If due dates change, they will be updated as soon as possible on the website as well. This website is a good tool for both students and adults that are responsible for students in this class.

Please note that if you are absent, it is your responsibility to look at the website to see what was missed and also ask a classmate. While I can answer follow-up questions, it is essential that you ask classmates before asking me.

Submitting Work

Assignments must be submitted via Teams under the assignment submission tabs. This goes for all assignments unless otherwise explicitly written on the assignment handout. Assignments submitted via email will not be accepted. If you are struggling with turning in an assignment on Teams, please ask a classmate or friend to help you. If that does not work, please come see me prior to the assignment due date.

Late Submission of Assignments

The late penalty for assignments is 5% per day after the submission deadline. After 7 days, the assignment will no longer be accepted. This policy is set in place for multiple reasons. One of the reasons being that handing work in late simply creates a pile-up of assignments and can contribute to feeling overwhelmed. Another reason being that deadlines help teach/learn management skills and accountability.

Incomplete Assignments

Any work that is not handed in will receive a 0%.

Resubmission of Assignments

The resubmission must be asked for in written form (either via email or TEAMS). A resubmission deadline will be stated by the teacher. The student must make considerable changes to the assignment and must show proof of those changes. Either with notes in the margin(s) or by highlighting the new content that was changed or added. The original assignment with teacher feedback must be handed in as well. If the original assignment is not handed in with the resubmission, the teacher reserves the right to not accept the resubmitted assignment.

Resubmissions are welcome because the goal of all assignments is to learn and become better at a skill or understanding a topic/issue. Hence, resubmissions must be taken seriously.

Homework

In almost all circumstances, enough time will be given in class to complete various assignments throughout the year. That being said, if someone is absent or if class time is not used wisely, it becomes the student's responsibility to complete the incomplete work at home. Students become responsible for completing any work that is not done in class within the given amount of time.
